# MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The YMCA of Greater Kansas City offers an inclusive membership to any Y in the area.

## GUESTS

As a member of the YMCA of Greater Kansas City, you are welcome to bring guests. With your membership, you will receive three free visit passes each calendar year that can be used at your discretion. Additional guest visits can be purchased for a nominal fee at the Welcome Center. All guests must provide a photo ID at each visit. Members must be at least 16 years old to sponsor a guest. Use of certain areas of the facility may be restricted. Please inquire at your center for complete details.

## DAY PASSES

Child (ages 12 weeks to 8 years old) **\$3**  
Youth (ages 9-12) **\$5**

Individual (ages 13 and up) **\$10**  
Family **\$20**

## MEMBERSHIP CANCELLATION

The Y requires no long-term contracts; however, a 30-day written notice is required to cancel.

## AWAY PROGRAM (Always Welcome at Ys)

The Y AWAY program allows your membership to be recognized at participating Ys across the country. Y members from outside the greater Kansas City area may visit Kansas City facilities three times a year at no charge. After three visits there is a \$2 daily fee. For visiting members who plan to use the Y during a long-term visit, a monthly AWAY pass may be purchased for \$20. Proof of current Y membership is required.

## PUTTING A MEMBERSHIP ON HOLD

In the case of short-term absences, the YMCA of Greater Kansas City will consider putting a hold on your membership for a maximum of three consecutive months. This privilege is at the discretion of the Y executive director and may be exercised one time during a calendar year. A \$10 per month administrative fee will be charged as an automatic draft during the approved hold period. After the requested hold period is completed, your monthly automatic draft will resume.

## Reasons for putting a membership on hold include the following:

- Health reasons. Examples may include surgical procedures, maternity leave and short-term health conditions.
- Absence from the greater Kansas City area for less than three months. Examples may include leaving the area for weather conditions, summer breaks, business travel and/or military leave.
- Seasonal activities. Examples may include participating in traveling sports teams, high school sports teams, high school sports and/or activities.

## ATTIRE

Attire suitable for a family facility is required at all times and in all areas of the Y. All attire must have graphics and language appropriate for a family environment. Proper shoes are required in the wellness centers, aerobic studio and basketball courts. Swimsuits are required when using the pool or whirlpool. Cutoffs and street clothes are not permitted in the pool area.

## AGE REQUIREMENTS FOR USE IN OUR CENTERS WITHOUT ADULT SUPERVISION

- Ages 9 -12 can be unaccompanied by a parent/adult for 2 hours in our centers.
- Ages 13-15 can be unaccompanied by a parent/adult for 3 hours in our centers.
- Ages 16 and older can have unlimited time alone in the facility in our centers.

Anyone not in accordance with our code of conduct will be asked to leave. If that person is a minor, their parent or guardian will be notified for immediate pick up.

## SMOKING POLICY

All Y facilities are smoke-free environments. Smoking or use of any tobacco products is not permitted in the Y buildings or on Y grounds.

## SAFETY/SECURITY

When visiting the Y, please bring a lock and secure your belongings, including car keys and wallets, at all times. Valuables are best left at home. Never leave a wallet, purse or cell phone locked in your car while you work out. The Y is not responsible for theft or damage to your property.

Please help us assure safety in each facility by reporting any suspicious or questionable activity. Cameras are not allowed in locker rooms.

The Y staff is trained to deal with blood-borne pathogens and open wounds. All necessary equipment is available at the Y. We reserve the right to limit or restrict the use of our facilities if there is a risk of spreading or transferring any communicable or infectious diseases.

## CODE OF CONDUCT AND ENFORCEMENT POLICY

Any member engaging in inappropriate behavior in Y facilities or on its grounds will have their membership privileges suspended immediately. Permanent termination will be determined by the Y Board of Directors. Anyone who witnesses inappropriate behavior is encouraged to report it immediately to an on-duty staff member.
